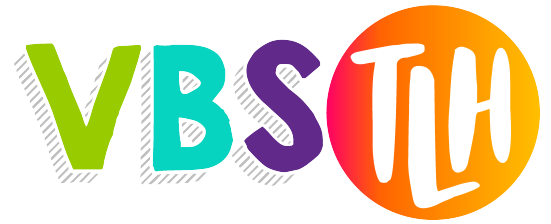


Preschool Craft Rotation



Day 2

Fork Painting

Day 2 Supply List

- Plastic Forks (2 per child)
- Yellow & Orange Paint
- White paper
- Disposable plates
- Smock (optional)
- Newspaper (optional)

Day 2 Instructions

Prep: Pour quarter size amount of pain onto disposable plates.

Tip: Cover craft area surface with newspaper to protect surface from paint. Consider drawing circles as guides for younger preschoolers to stamp/paint onto.

1. Dip a fork into the yellow or orange paint and press the back of the fork onto the paper. Repeat this step numerous times to make a circular pattern. Make two or more “bright light” circles on the page.
2. Print Today’s Point on the paper: “Jesus loves me no matter what.”

Day 2 Connection

Remind preschoolers that they learned how Jesus got Paul’s attention and how Paul listened and obeyed. Paul saw a light so bright that it hurt his eyes. He also heard Jesus’ voice. Show kids how their painting looks like bright lights!
