Day 3 Instructions

SUGAR WAFER TRUCKS

1. Cover a cookie sheet with parchment paper. Use this as your work surface.
2. Melt white candy melts and put into icing or zip top bag.
3. Cut small corner off bag to allow candy melt to be used as "glue."
4. Cut some of the sugar wafers into thirds.
5. Place a whole sugar wafer on your work surface.
6. Use candy melt "glue" to glue two of the smaller wafer pieces, one on top of the other to one side of the whole wafer. This will be the cab of your truck--where the driver sits!
7. Use the candy melt "glue" to load the truck with lumber. Glue one pretzel stick at a time onto the back of the truck in a small pile.
8. Use candy melt glue to attach the truck to Rolos (tires).
